The Wichita Family Crisis Center works to eliminate domestic violence in our community by supporting survivors through shelter, education, and advocacy.

- Advocacy Services and Safety Planning -Advocates available to meet individually with survivors to provide immediate crisis intervention, safety planning, supportive counseling, and access to referral services.
- 24-Hour Hotline Advocates available to provide immediate crisis intervention and safety planning services.
- Court Advocacy Advocates provide support to survivors as they move through the legal court systems and access protective orders.
- Medical Advocacy Advocates respond onsite to medical and mental health facilities to provide support and assistance to survivors in accessing services related to domestic violence.
- Education and Outreach Individual and group support sessions are available for anyone in an abusive relationship.
 Staff also provide community groups with information about domestic violence and the resources available in the community.
